As a commercial expedition leader, I have worked for the World Challenge, Outlook Expeditions, Venture Force and schools in the UK, US, NZ, and Australia. In this role I have gained valuable experience of team management, problem solving, budgeting, dealing with medical issues (including acute mountain sickness, dislocations, fractures, malaria), risk assessment and management, facilitation of experiential learning and personal development.

I love the outdoors. Working in the outdoors is the best and most inspiring job in the world! Over the years I have worked hard to gain the Mountaineering and Climbing Instructor Award, the highest outdoor qualification, which allows me to teach, coach, mentor, and guide all aspects of rock climbing, scrambling, and mountaineering, as well as provide technical expertise in these areas.

I enjoy teaching people to rock climb, guiding classic multi-pitch routes, leading expeditions and winter mountaineering adventures, and sharing my knowledge of these amazing activities with others. Snowdonia and the Lake District are my favourite venues — not least because they have some of the most scenic and most easily accessible mountains. I am passionate about the environment and promote sustainable enjoyment of the mountains. Safety is at the heart of everything I do to make sure you have a fantastic, memorable, and fun adventure. My knowledge and experience enable me to tailor activities

to suit anyone regardless of ability, gender, race, and age. I believe in undiscovered potential in everyone and help people achieve things they never thought possible.
